### COMING APRIL 2022 Himmel Award and Conversation Honoring The Haas Brothers

Experience the world of acclaimed artists the Haas Brothers (Simon and Nikolai Haas), as they discuss their clever, imaginative, and fantasy-filled creations which merge the realms of craft, design, and contemporary art. Playful and at times irreverent, they explore aesthetic themes related to nature, science fiction, sexuality,

and psychedelia. Their inventive use of materials ranges from copper, porcelain and fur, to technical resins and polyurethane. Followed by Q&A, hors d'oeuvres, and cocktails.

*The Himmel Award is presented in honor of Betty Himmel "in recognition of creators, conceivers, radical thinkers, and risk-takers that provoke new thinking in art and design."*

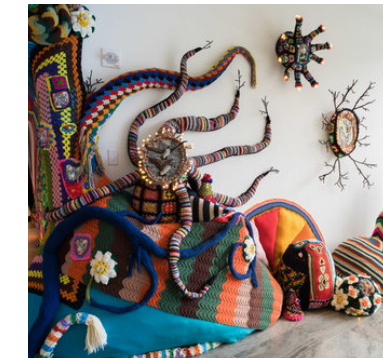
### Craft & Connect Adult Art Workshop Creative Clay Thursday, June 9 5:30 PM – 7:30 PM
